

THIS AMENDMENT, entered into between the **Florida Department of Children and Families**, hereinafter referred to as the "Department" and **South Florida Behavioral Health Network, Inc.**, hereinafter referred to as the "Provider," amends **Contract No. KH225**.

PREAMBLE: This amendment adds language to expand Miami-Dade Forensic Alternative Center (MDFAC) services to allow admissions of eligible Broward County residents. Additionally, this amendment includes language in regard to statewide forensic beds by making services available to consumers from other circuits. As a result, Attachment I, Section D., Special Provisions, is amended.

1. Page 76, Attachment I, Section D., Special Provisions, Paragraph 24. is hereby added to read:

- 24.** For the following programs, the Managing Entity shall make services available to consumers from other Circuits through their Subcontracted Providers at:
1. **Public Health Trust/Jackson Health System** – Miami-Dade Forensic Alternative Center (MDFAC) – Up to six (6) beds shall be available to Broward residents who meet MDFAC's Eligibility Criteria, which is incorporated herein by reference and can be obtained from the Contract Manager upon request. MDFAC is a locked and staff secured facility intended to serve adult forensic consumers charged with second and third degree felonies who are committed to the department under Sections 916.13 and 916.15, F.S. These consumers have been found by a circuit court to be incompetent to proceed due to a serious mental illness or not guilty by reason of insanity and who do not have a significant history of violence.
 2. **Citrus Health Network, Inc.** - Eight (8) statewide residential beds in the Safe Transition and Access to Recovery (STAR) Program shall be available to eligible consumers in need of forensic mental health services placed by the Managing Entity. The STAR Program provides intensive, short-term treatment to individuals who are temporarily in need of a structured therapeutic setting in a less restrictive but longer-stay alternative to hospitalization.
 3. **Passageway Residence of Dade County, Inc.** – Fourteen (14) statewide residential beds shall be available to eligible consumers in Residential Level II who are in need of forensic mental health services placed by the Managing Entity. Priority for admission to Passageway Residence of Dade County, Inc. will be given to individuals committed to the Florida Department of Children and Families, in accordance with the provisions of Florida Statutes Chapter 916, Forensic Services Act.
 4. **Psychosocial Rehabilitation Center d.b.a Fellowship House** - Four (4) statewide residential beds shall be available to eligible consumers in Residential Level II who are in need of forensic mental health services placed by the Managing Entity.

This amendment shall begin on **01/25/2013** or the date on which the amendment has been signed by both parties, whichever is later.

All provisions in the contract and any attachments thereto in conflict with this amendment shall be and are hereby changed to conform with this amendment.

All provisions not in conflict with this amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the level specified in the contract.

This amendment and all its attachments are hereby made a part of the contract.




